

Invitation letter to the 10th EITI Global Conference on 8-9 October 2026 in Brussels, Belgium

To whom it may concern,

The [Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative](#) (EITI), a global standard for the governance of oil, gas and mineral resources implemented by 55 countries worldwide, in cooperation with the Government of Belgium and the European Commission is hosting the 2026 EITI Global Conference on 8-9 October at SQUARE Brussels Meeting Centre in Brussels, Belgium.

The EITI Global Conference, held every three years, is the global forum of the EITI and its stakeholders. The conference, which is free of charge to attend, provides the primary opportunity for EITI stakeholders worldwide to meet, share and discuss information on progress and challenges in advancing the EITI.

The EITI Global Conference will take place on 8–9 October 2026. Prior to the conference, institutional meetings will be held on 5–7 October, including the 67th and 68th EITI Board meetings and the Members' Meeting.

Board members are therefore expected to arrive by 4 October and depart by 10 October.

Jeffrey Yates is expected to attend the institutional meetings and conference in Brussels in their capacity as an EITI Board member.
