Please accept my compliments of the highest esteem.

Per section 6.6 of the LEITI's Act, which states, "The members of the Multi-Stakeholders Group shall serve for a renewable term of three (3) years. A member of the MSG may resign his or her office at any time upon notice" and in line with the approved MSG procedures for nominating and changing constituency representative, especially count one of the procedures which states "The LEITI Secretariat shall inform all representatives from the Civil Society and Private Sector constituencies on the MSG through a written communication of the expiration of their tenure one (1) month ahead of the expiry; the Secretariat of the Liberia Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (LEITI) wishes to inform you of the expiration of the tenure of Mr. E. Ekema Witherspoon, the representative of the Forestry Sector on the MSG on October 31, 2024. Members of the current MSG were appointed on November 14, 2021.

Consequently, the LEITI Secretariat has begun coordinating the process to ensure that members of the new MSG are ready for appointment by the President of Liberia in early November of 2024.

Given the above and as the governing body of agriculture companies in Liberia, the Secretariat, in line with the LEITI Act, MSG Policy Manual, and Approved Policy for Nominating and Changing constituency representatives, requests your kindest cooperation in convening member organizations of the Liberia Agriculture Companies Association to either select or elect the agriculture sector's next representative for appointment to the MSG. To ensure compliance with the 2023 EITI Standard, the LEITI Act, MSG Policy Manual, and the MSG Approved Policy for Nominating and Changing constituency Representative, the Secretariat requests that the Association kindly document the process for election or



selection of the next representative and ensure that the document is signed by 2/3 of the overall membership of the Association.

The signed document, along with a letter nominating the new representative, should be submitted to the LEITI Secretariat on or before the close of the business day on October 31, 2024.
